## Passage of Study

Luke 9:1-9

<sup>1</sup> And He called the twelve together and gave them power and authority over all the demons and to heal diseases. <sup>2</sup> And He sent them out to proclaim the kingdom of God and to perform healing. <sup>3</sup> And He said to them, “Take nothing for *your* journey, neither a staff, nor a bag, nor bread, nor money; and do not *even* have two tunics apiece. <sup>4</sup> Whatever house you enter, stay there until you leave that city. <sup>5</sup> And as for those who do not receive you, as you go out from that city, shake the dust off your feet as a testimony against them.” <sup>6</sup> Departing, they began going throughout the villages, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere. <sup>7</sup> Now Herod the tetrarch heard of all that was happening; and he was greatly perplexed, because it was said by some that John had risen from the dead, <sup>8</sup> and by some that Elijah had appeared, and by others that one of the prophets of old had risen again. <sup>9</sup> Herod said, “I myself had John beheaded; but who is this man about whom I hear such things?” And he kept trying to see Him.
